1. From November 24 to 26, 2015, the United Nations Department of Safety and Security (UNDSS), together with the Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Center (CCOPAB, acronym in Portuguese), carried out the UN Course on Safe and Secure **Approaches** in Field



Environments (SSAFE) in the facilities of Itamaraty Palace and of CCOPAB. The aim of the course is to enable civilians of the United Nations to carry out field works taking safety and security into account.

2. On January 15, there was the Command Handover Ceremony at Brazilian Peace Operations Joint Training Center (CCOPAB, in Portuguese). acronym Ricardo Colonel Jose Vendramin Nunes handed over the command of CCOPAB to Coronel Carlos Augusto Ramires Teixeira. 3. From February 1 to 5, CCOPAB carried out the Unit Commanders and Joint Staff Course (EPCOEM, acronym in Portuguese) in its facilities. The course is directed to the officers who will be part of the next staff of the

Brazilian Battalion, Engineering Company and Marines Company, all in Haiti. During the previous week, CCOPAB had already taken part in the Meeting for the Command and Joint Staff of the 24th Brazilian Contingent (CONTBRAS) by lecturing on the UN Core Pre-Deployment Training Material (CPTM).



4. On <u>February 01</u>, there was the beginning of the UN Staff Officers Course (EPMP, acronym in Portuguese). The course, which lasted a week, had 07 students, among whom, the <u>first female officer</u> to be deployed as a

Gender and Children Protection Officer in the United Nations Mission Liberia (UNMIL). in week, Throughout the the students had different instructions related to the functioning and organization of UN Peace Operations and to with how to work military personnel from other nations.



5. From <u>February 15 to 26</u>, CCOPAB carried out the Subunit Commanders and Platoon Leaders Course (EPCOSUPEL, acronym in Portuguese) in order to prepare the 24th Brazilian Contingent to be deployed to the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti. The participants learned

about Peace Operations, mainly focusing on the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti (MINUSTAH). They practiced firstaid, learned about International Law, trained in the shooting simulator and in field exercises, handled non-lethal weapons and practiced combat



techniques for urban environments.
